



STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS): 2022-23

The survey was conducted in the month of November, 2022 among the 1st Semester, 3rd Semester, 5th Semester students of this college. The questions in the questionnaire were mixture of 5-point Likert scale questions, dichotomous questions and one open-ended question. It was optional for the students to participate in the survey. Only 297 students responded and among them, 186 (63%) were girls and rest 111(37%) were boys.




Is the teaching and mentoring that takes place in the college useful?
 Out of the 297 students a large portion (63%) reported that teaching and mentoring were significantly helpful and 32% of the students reported teaching and mentoring were very well. Insignificantly only 5% students reported that as moderately useful.


2. Are the Course and Programme Outcomes Explained to the Students?

Out of all the responding students 61% students reported that course outcomes and programme outcomes were explained to them by the teachers every time and 36% of the student reported that course outcomes and programme outcomes were usually explained to them. Only 3% of the respondents reported that as occasionally/sometimes.



3. Are the assessment criteria for the courses explained to you at the beginning of the semester/academic year?



4. How effective is the faculty in communicating the content of the courses they teach?




5. How effective are the teachers in teaching new and challenging topics?

6. Do teachers use examples and applications to explain concepts in order to make the course interesting and relevant?




7. How well do you think the faculties prepare for the classes?

8. Are student-centric methods, like participative learning and problem-solving methods used for enhancing the learning process?



9. Do teachers make an effort to identify your weaknesses and help you overcome them?




10. Do the teachers check on you with regard to your academic and co-curricular responsibilities?


11. Are the teachers open for academic guidance after class?




13. Is the evaluation of the internal examinations/assignments/tutorials fair?

90% of the respondents reported that **every time** assignments/ tutorials were returned to them within a reasonable time period and remaining 10% reported that as **usually**.




15. Are the results of internal exams/test available online one month within the completion of the examination?


16. Are the teachers willing to discuss assignments/tests/exam question paper and answer scripts with you?

17. Do you feel the need for remedial teaching?


Whether students feel the need for remedial teaching, 7% of the students feel every time, 62% reported that they feel usually and 31% of the students feel Occasionally/Sometimes.




19. Do the teachers treat you with respect?

All the students reported that they were treated with respect.


20. How would you rate the quality of the teaching-learning process in the college?




21. Are you offered add-on/enrichment courses to provide you greater opportunities for learning and growth?

22. Are you given the opportunity to go on field visits as and when needed?



23. Does the college try to involve students in evaluating and improving the teaching-learning process?


When asked about whether the college tries to involve students in evaluating and improving the teaching-learning process, 73% of the respondents reported affirmative and the remaining 27% reported as negative.






24. Are you encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities?

25. Does the college engage in imparting soft skills?




26. Does the college impart employability skills?

27. Considering the constraints of space and topography in the college, are you satisfied with the sports facilities provided to you?




28. Has participation in NSS and other societies in the college helped in your overall development?
